- Applicants will then be considered and selected on a rolling basis, depending on the need(s) of the Committee, applicant qualifications and areas of expertise, and any other applicable factors.

- Candidates who are members of ISI and have direct knowledge of infrastructure practices and Envision interest and use. Student members and young professionals are encouraged to apply.
- Candidates who are active ENV SP credential holders and believe they could contribute to ISI and the uptake of Envision use.
- Candidates who are already advocates for/interested in advocating for Envision use.
- Candidate who have expertise in Envision implementation and continuing education course development.
