Call for Posters

Submission Requirements

Complete the attached form with an abstract. Abstracts should include a summary of the project, whether the project/research is ongoing or complete, and the project's relevance to sustainability and application of the Envision framework.

Abstracts will be reviewed based on quality, topical relevance, and application of the Envision framework.

Submit abstracts to Lindsey Geiger no later than **October 10, 2022**. Poster presenters will be notified of acceptance by November 2nd and virtual poster presentation orientation will be scheduled for the week of November 7th.

Accepted poster presenters will prepare a digital poster to be shared virtually. Accepted poster presenters will submit their final posters to ISI as 1-page PDFs for distribution to conference participants.

Accepted poster presenters may be eligible to win a prize.
