Collaborated with the then **Zofnass Program for Sustainable Infrastructure at the Harvard Graduate School of Design** to develop a sustainability rating system for infrastructure. The first version of the **Envision Sustainable Infrastructure Framework** was introduced in 2012.



The now **Zofnass Research Program** moved from Harvard to ISI in 2022 to support ongoing industry research, development, and application.






























