The now **Zofnass Research Program** moved from Harvard to ISI in 2022 to support ongoing industry research, development, and application.

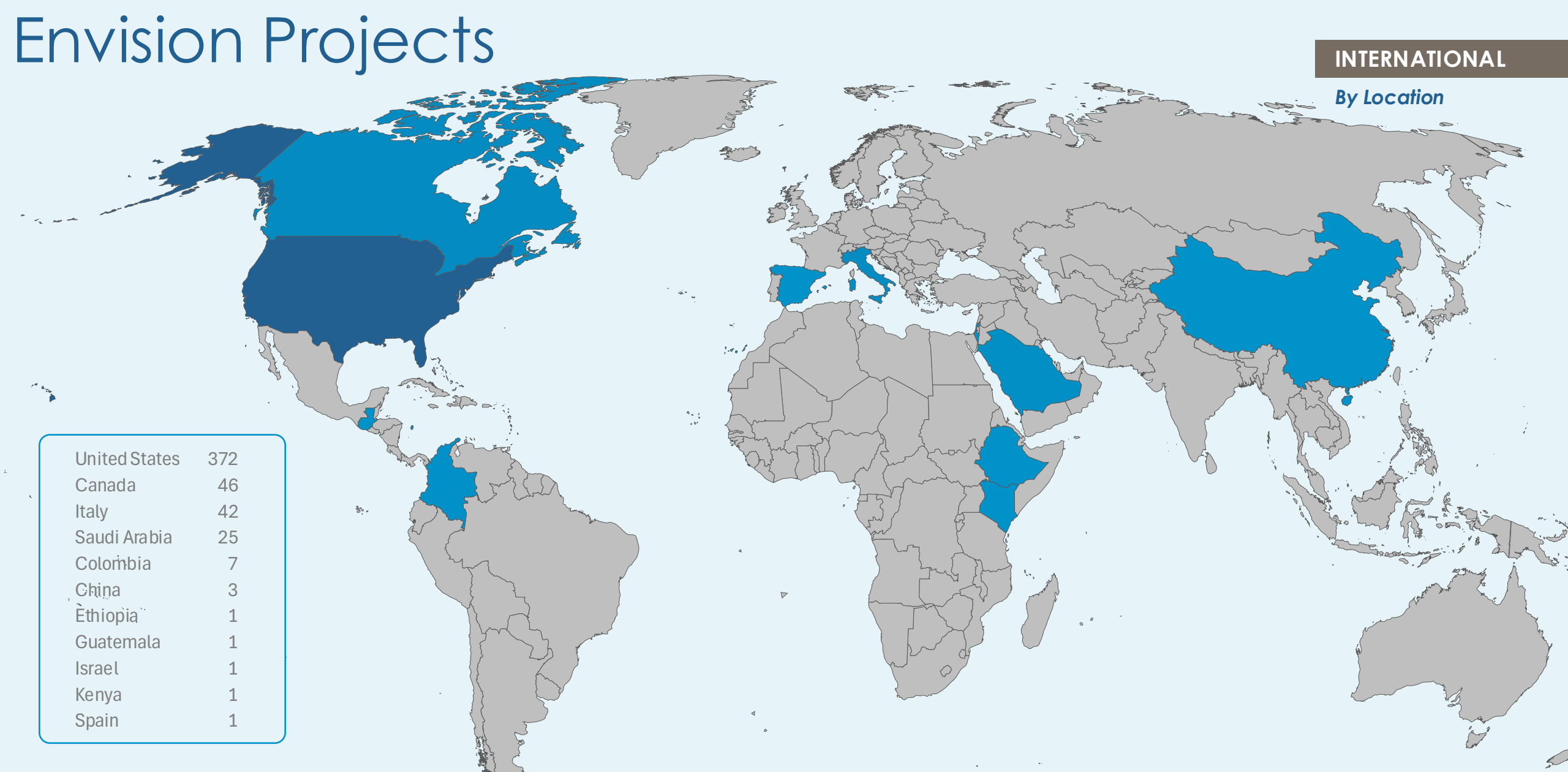

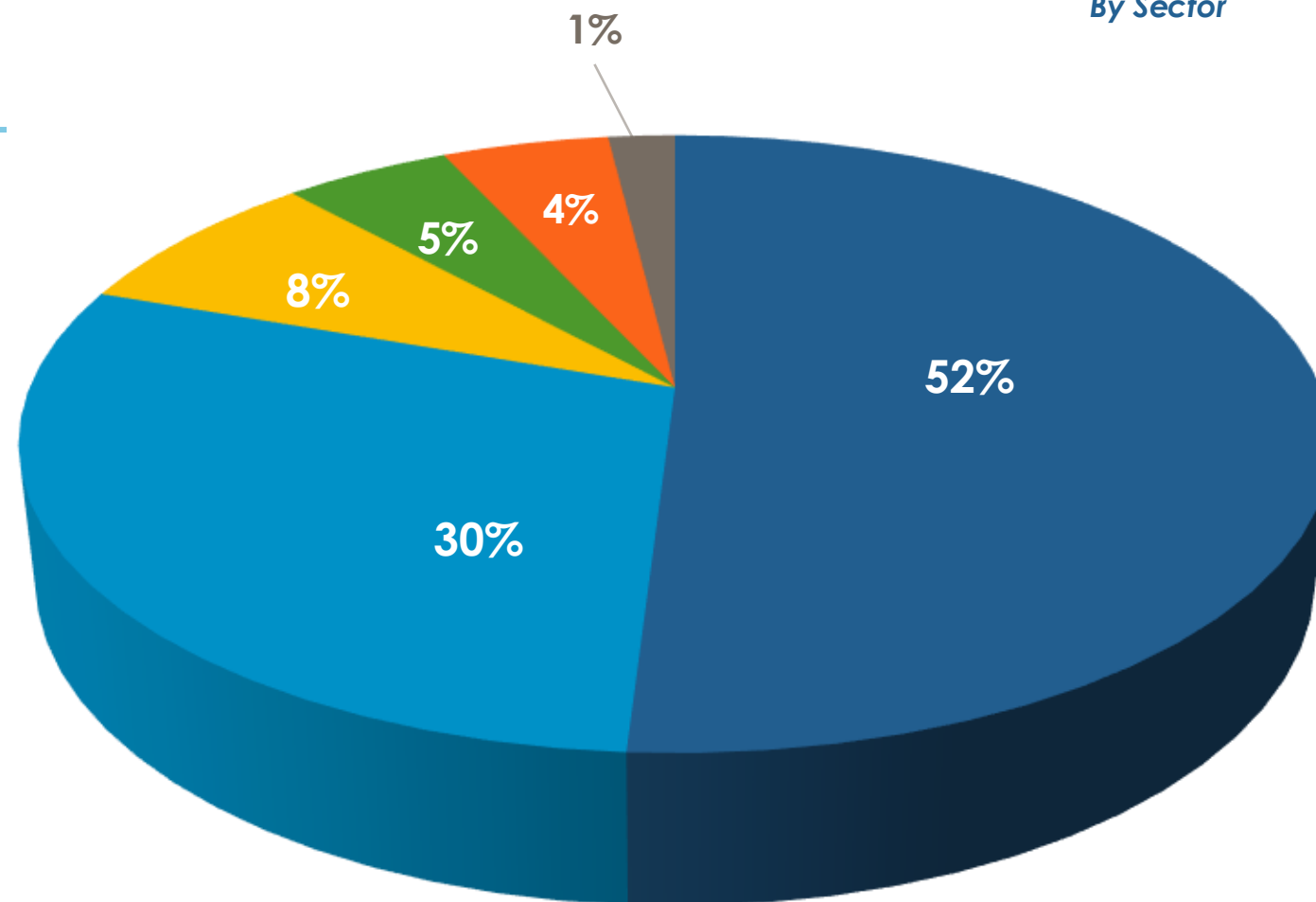

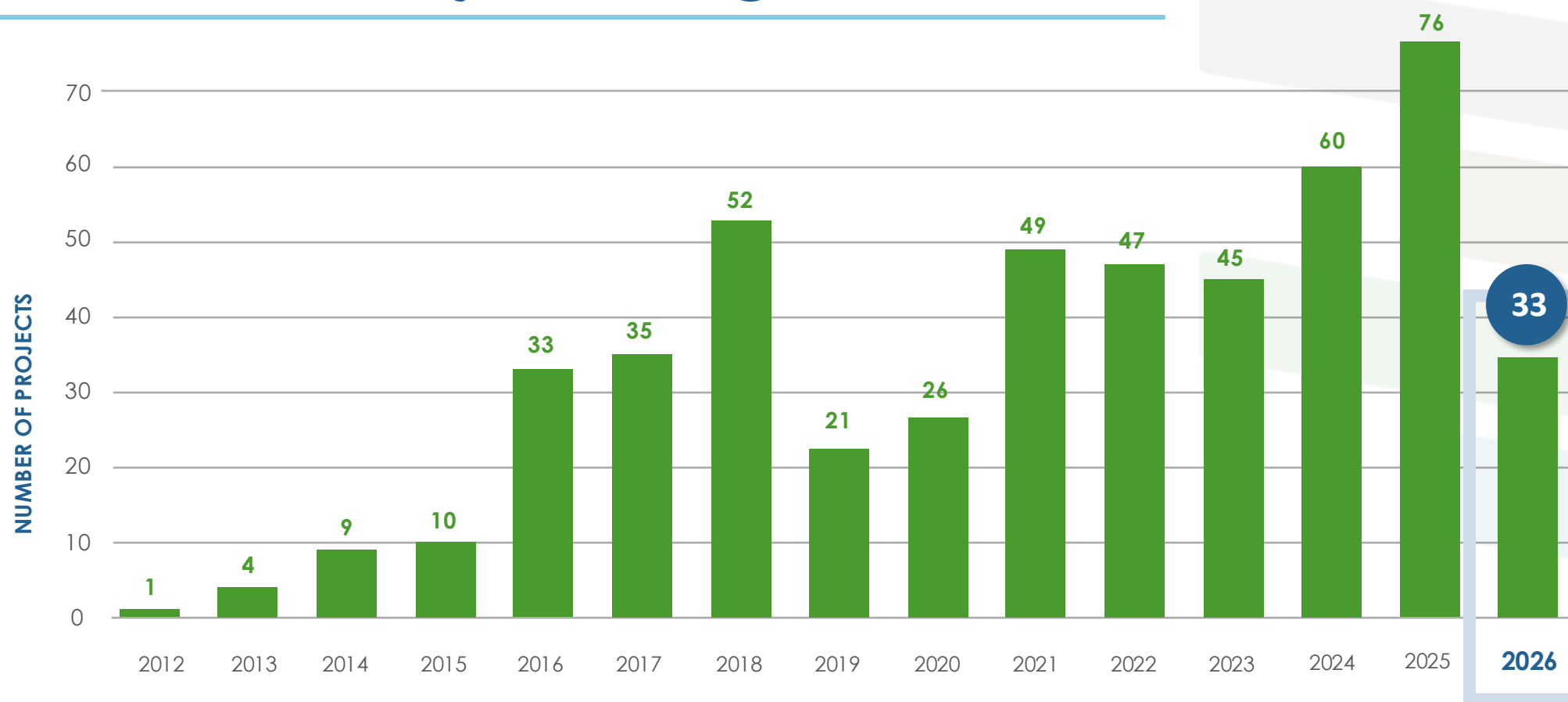

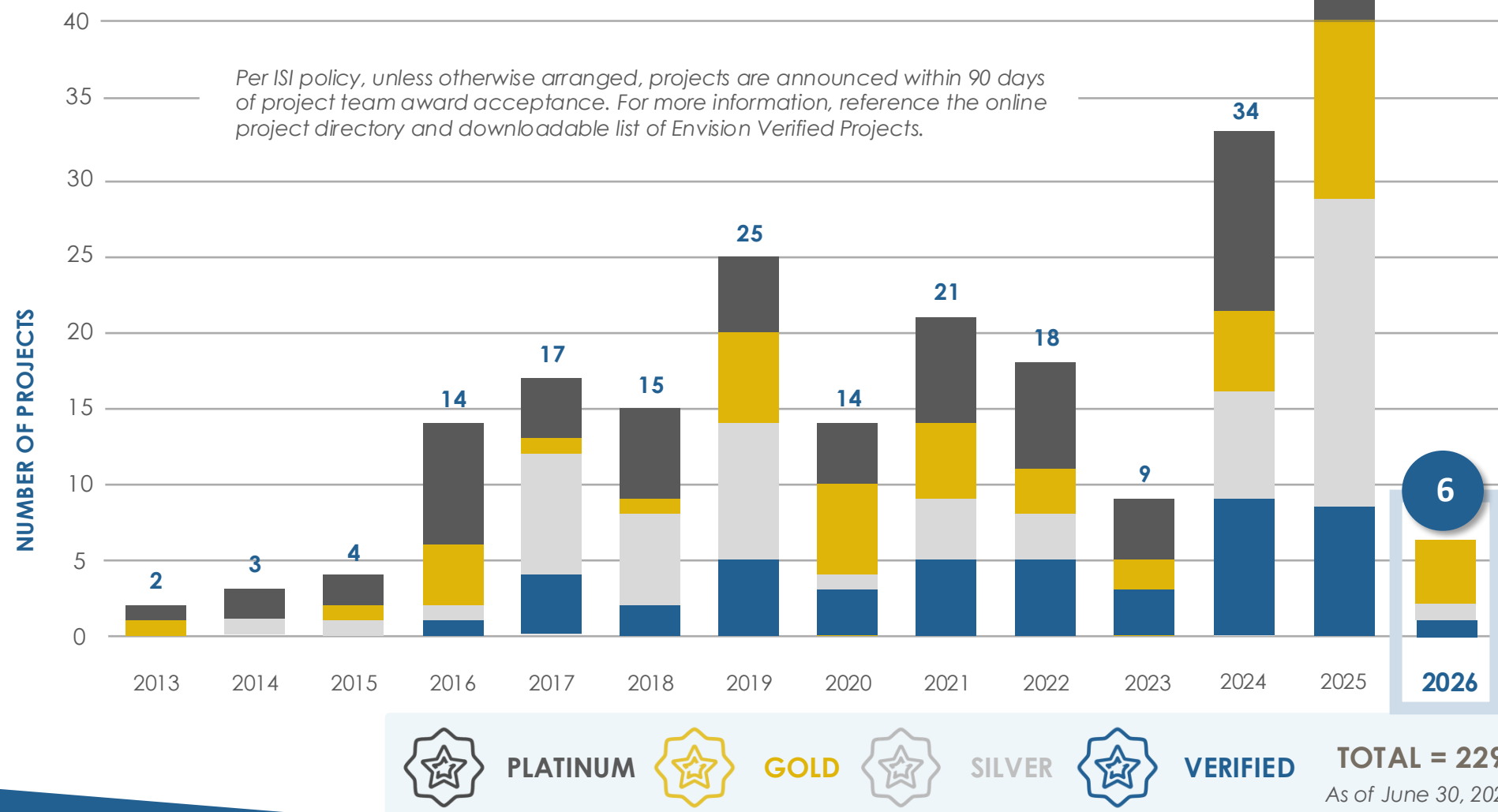

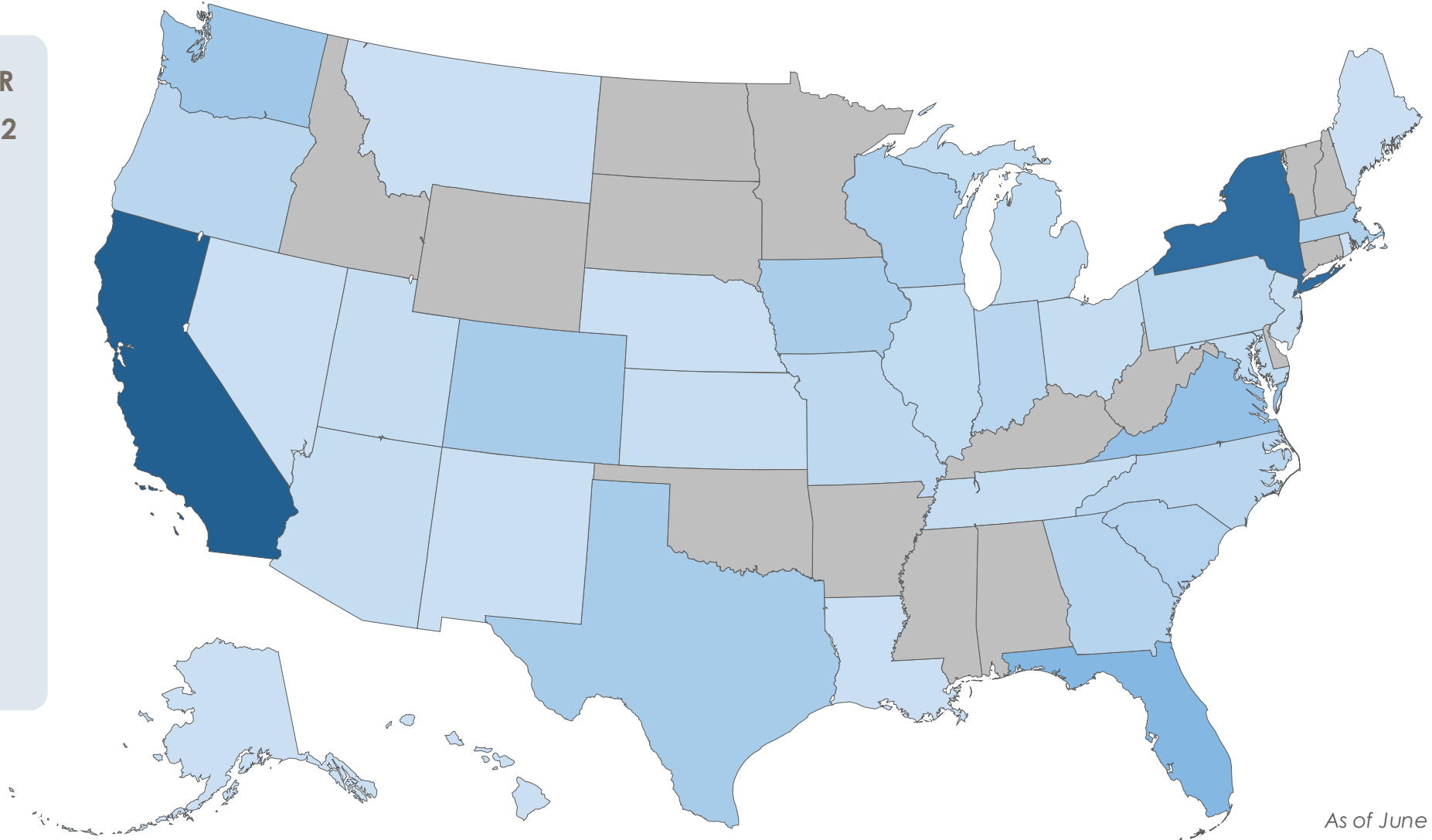

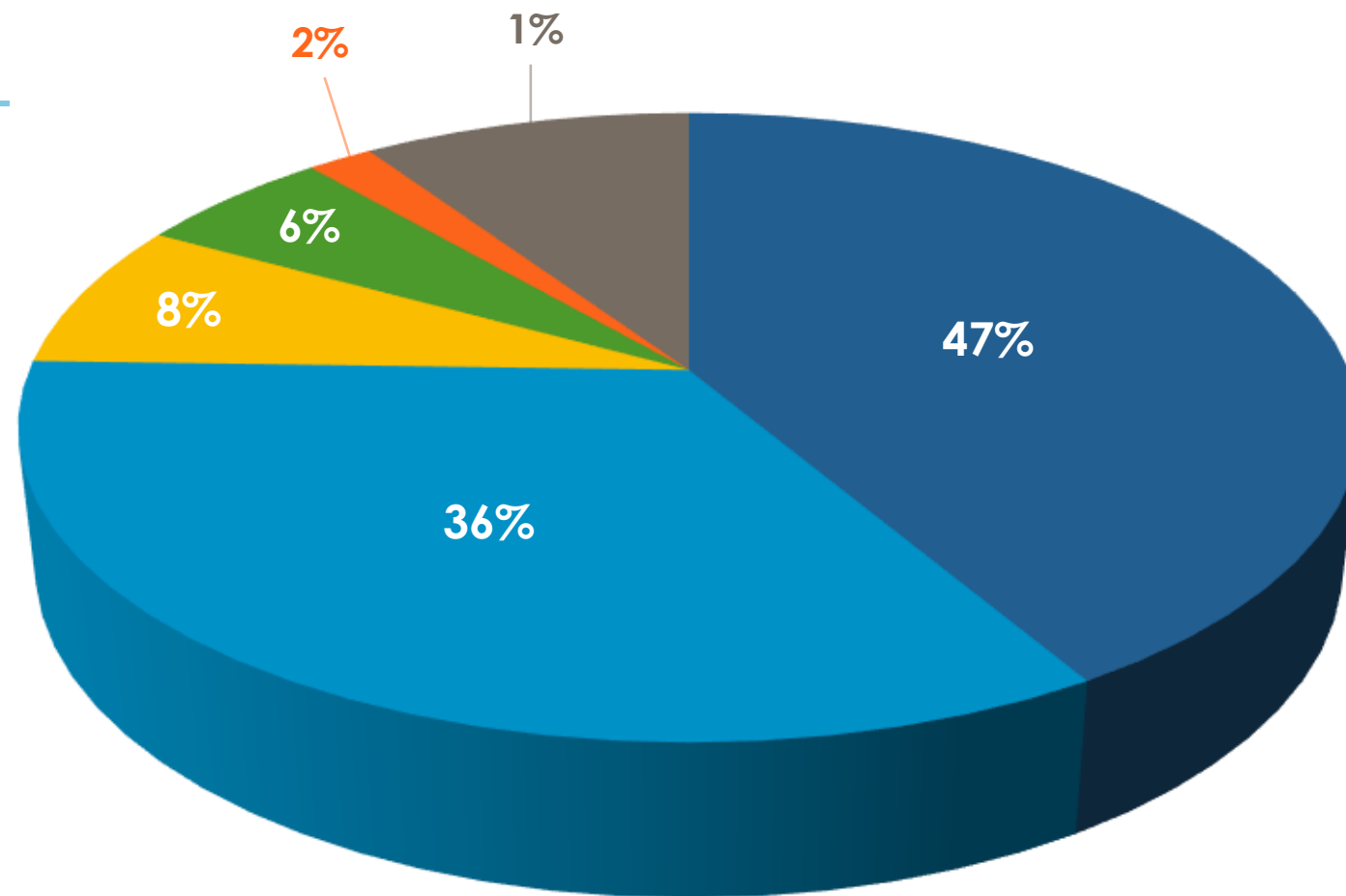

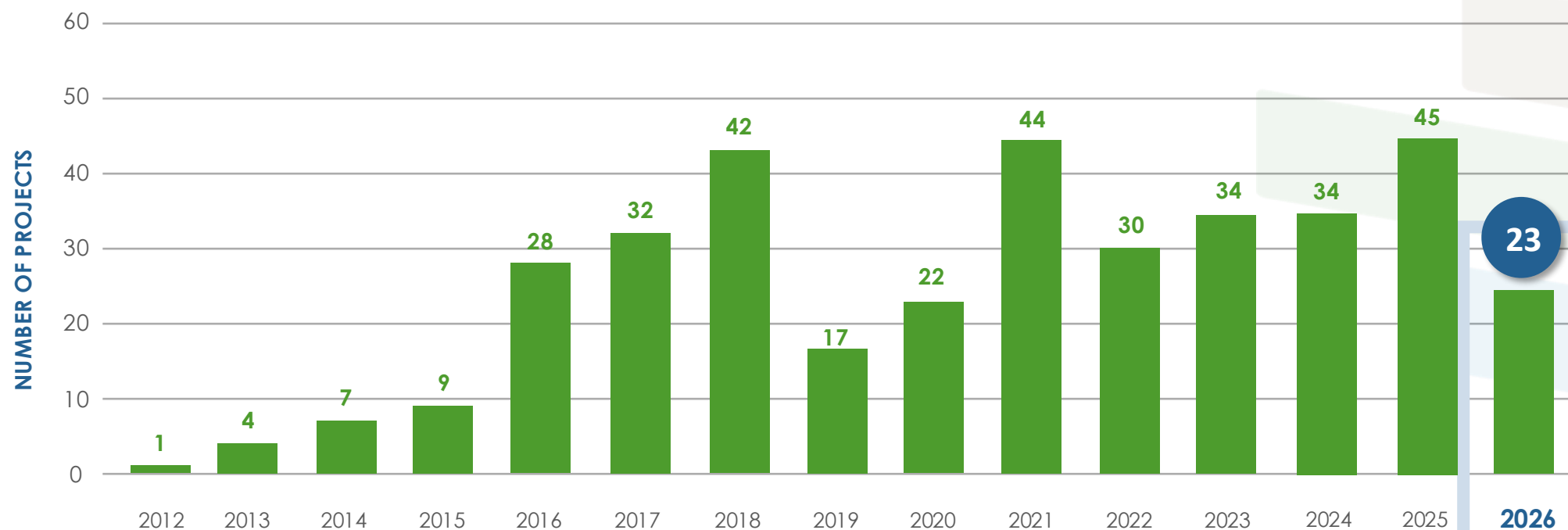

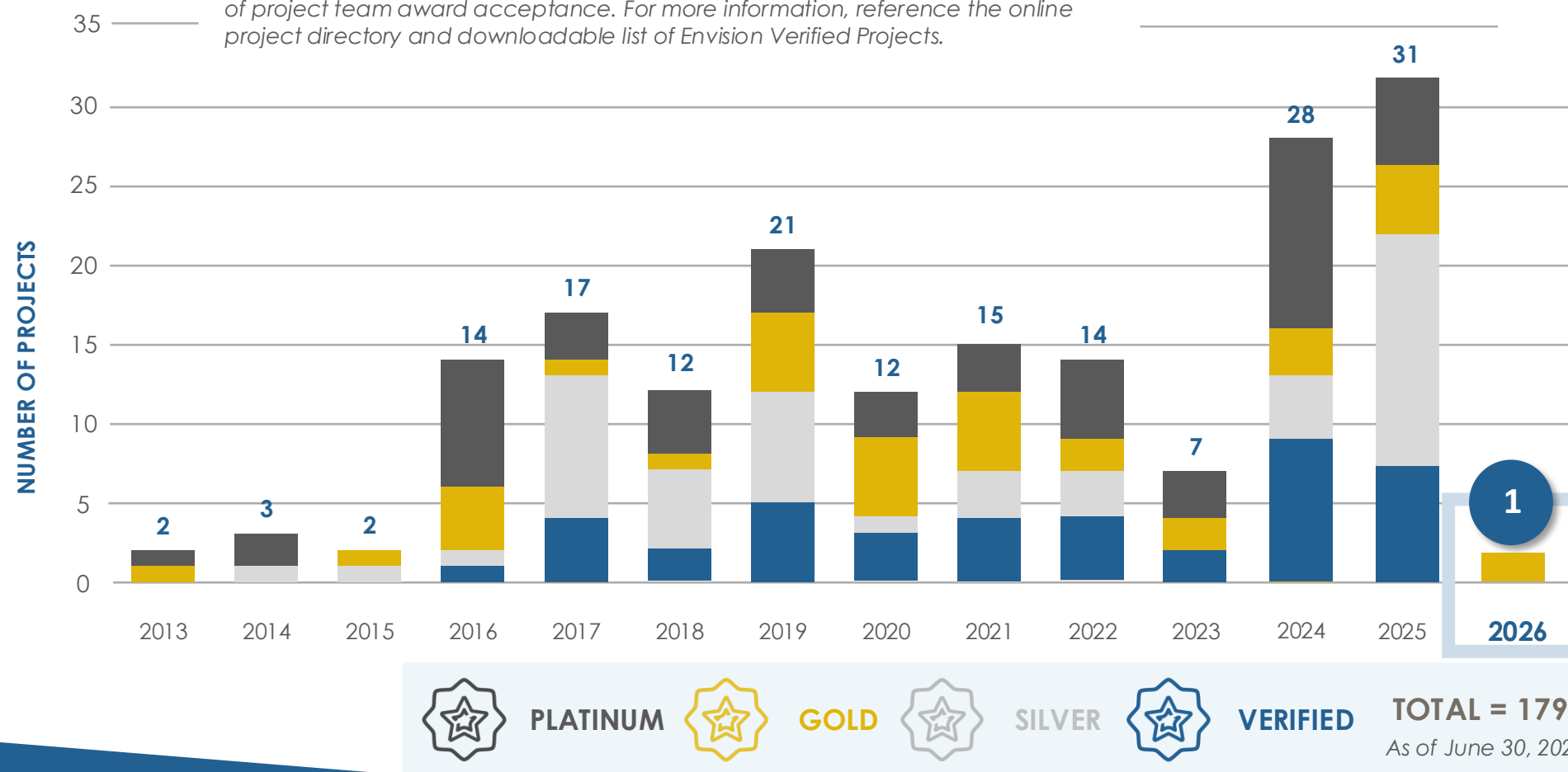

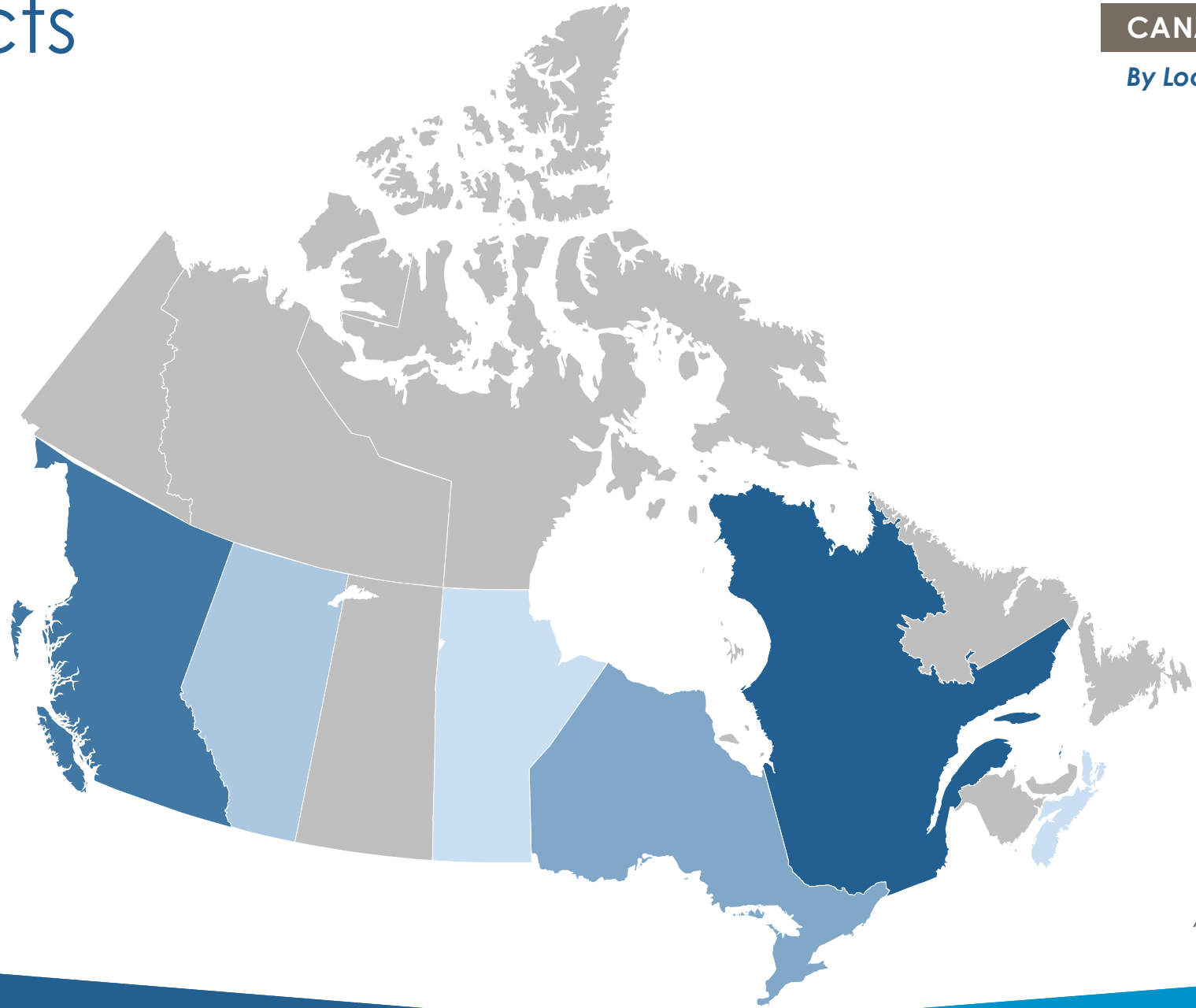

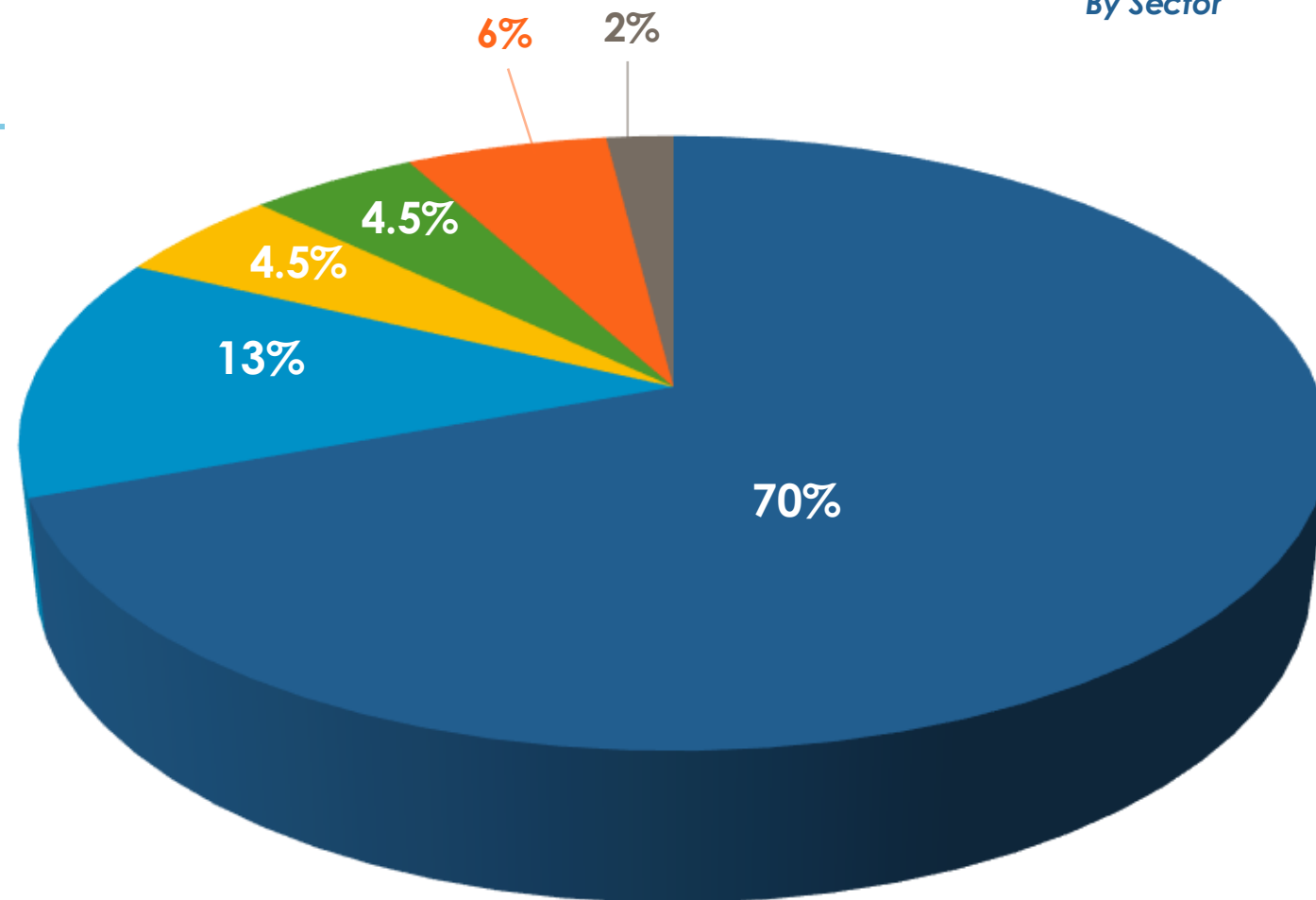

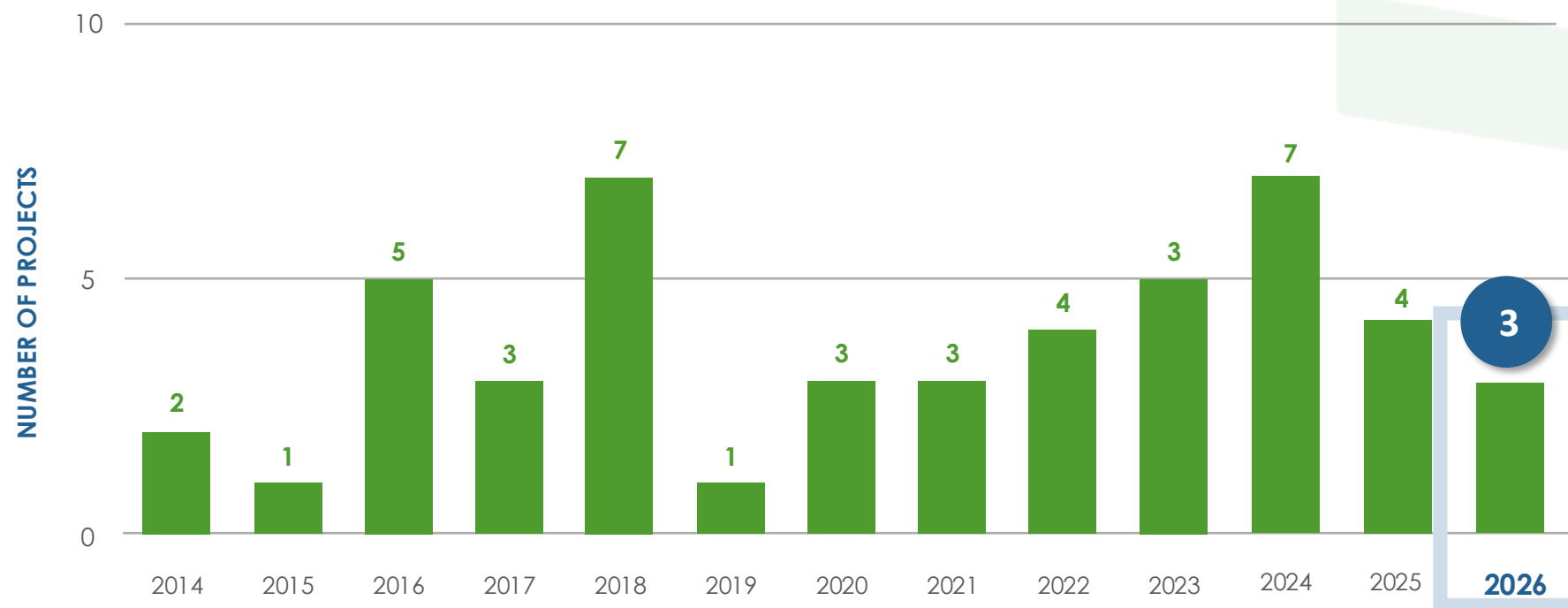

Envision Project Registrations

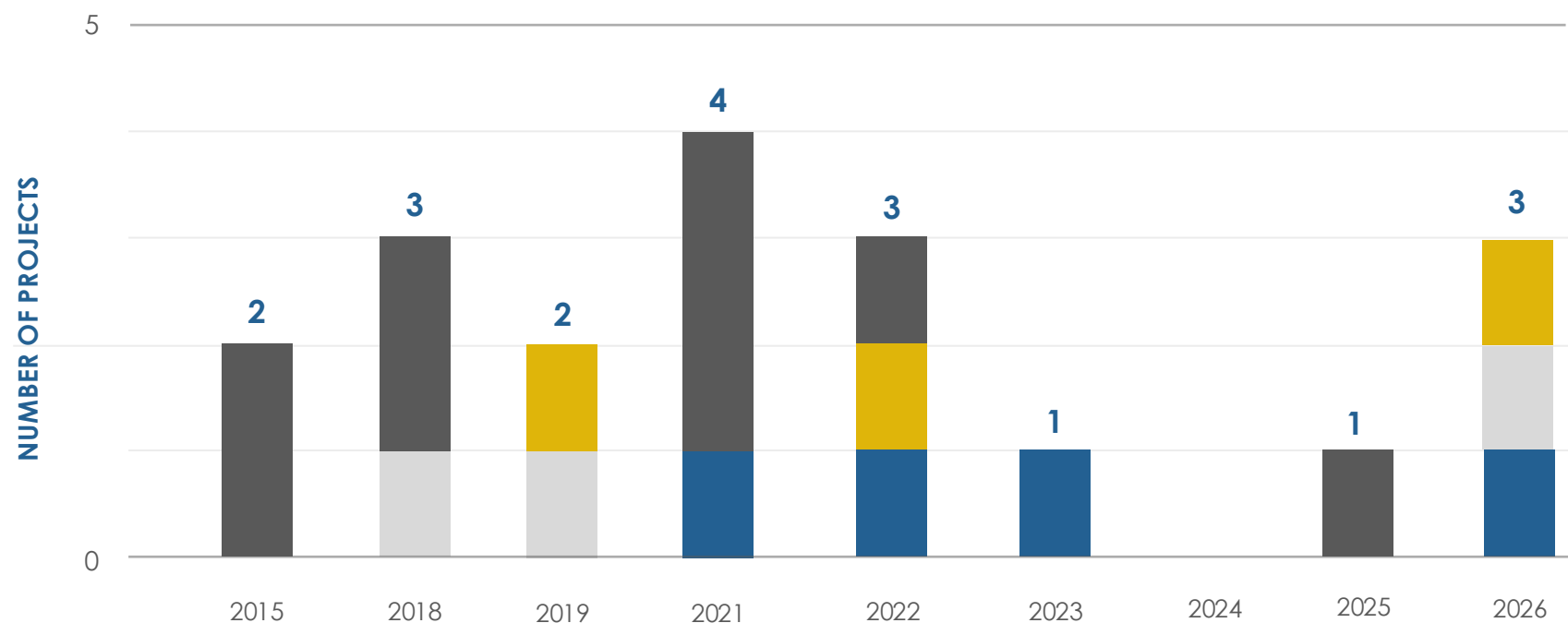

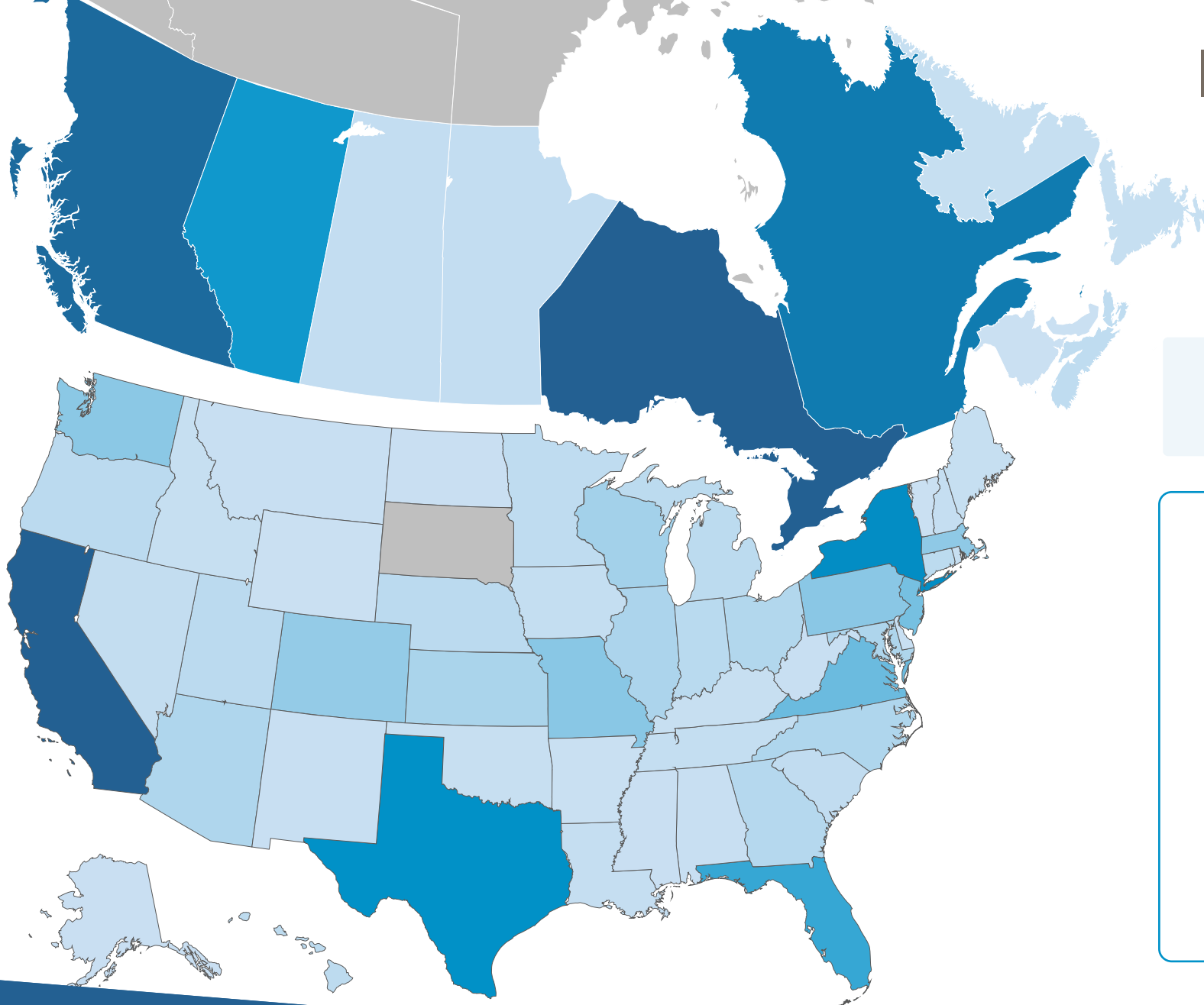

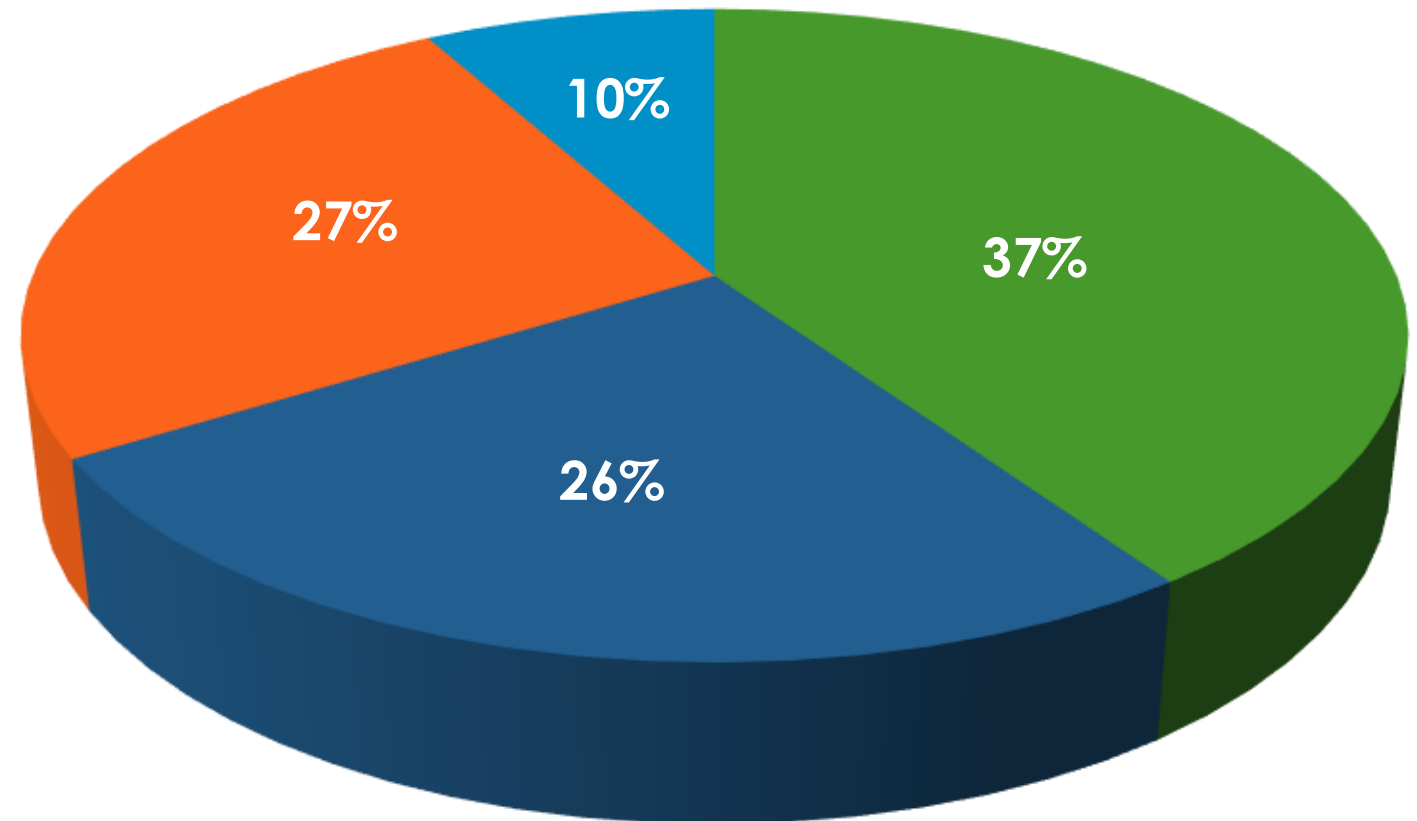

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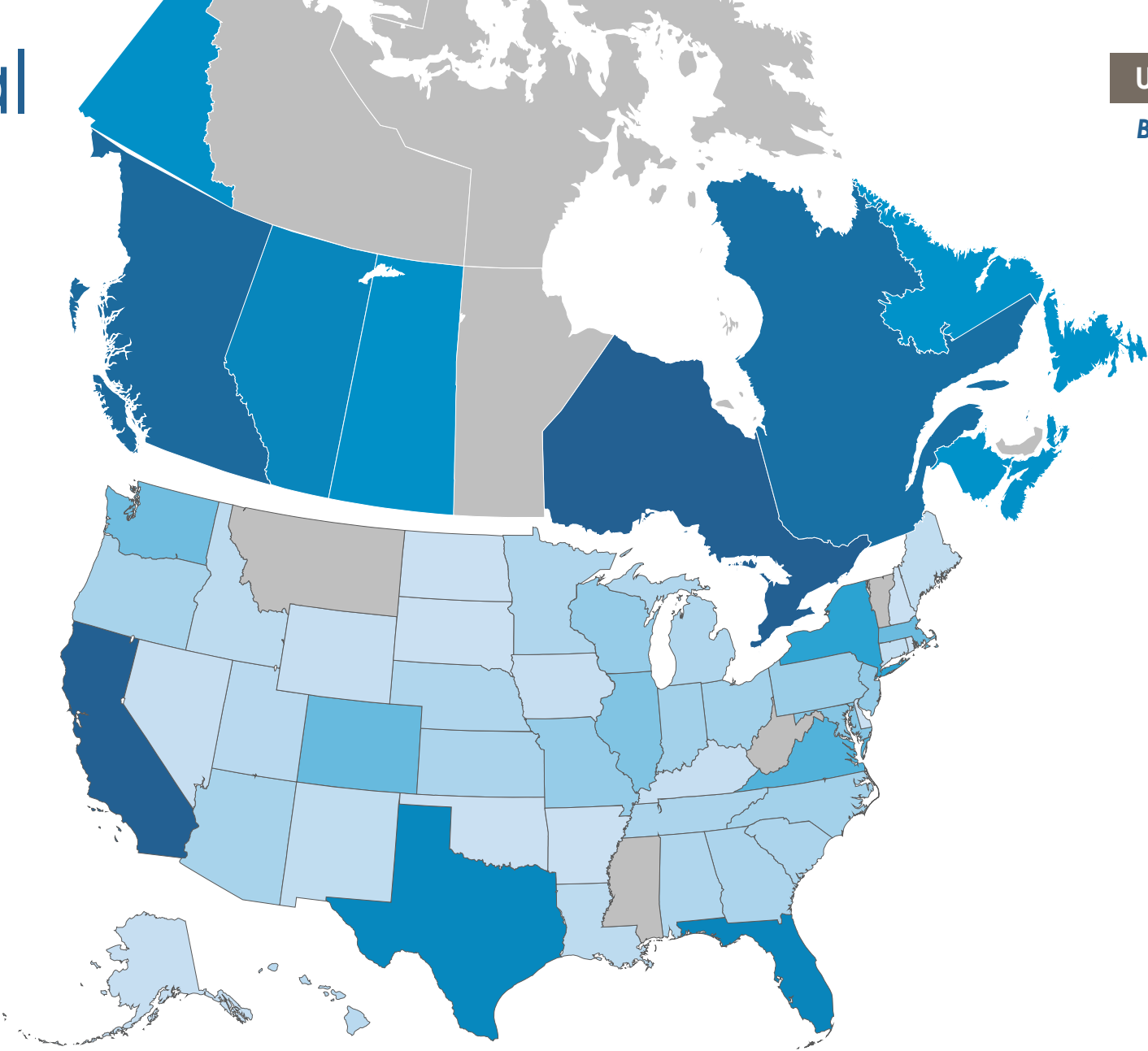

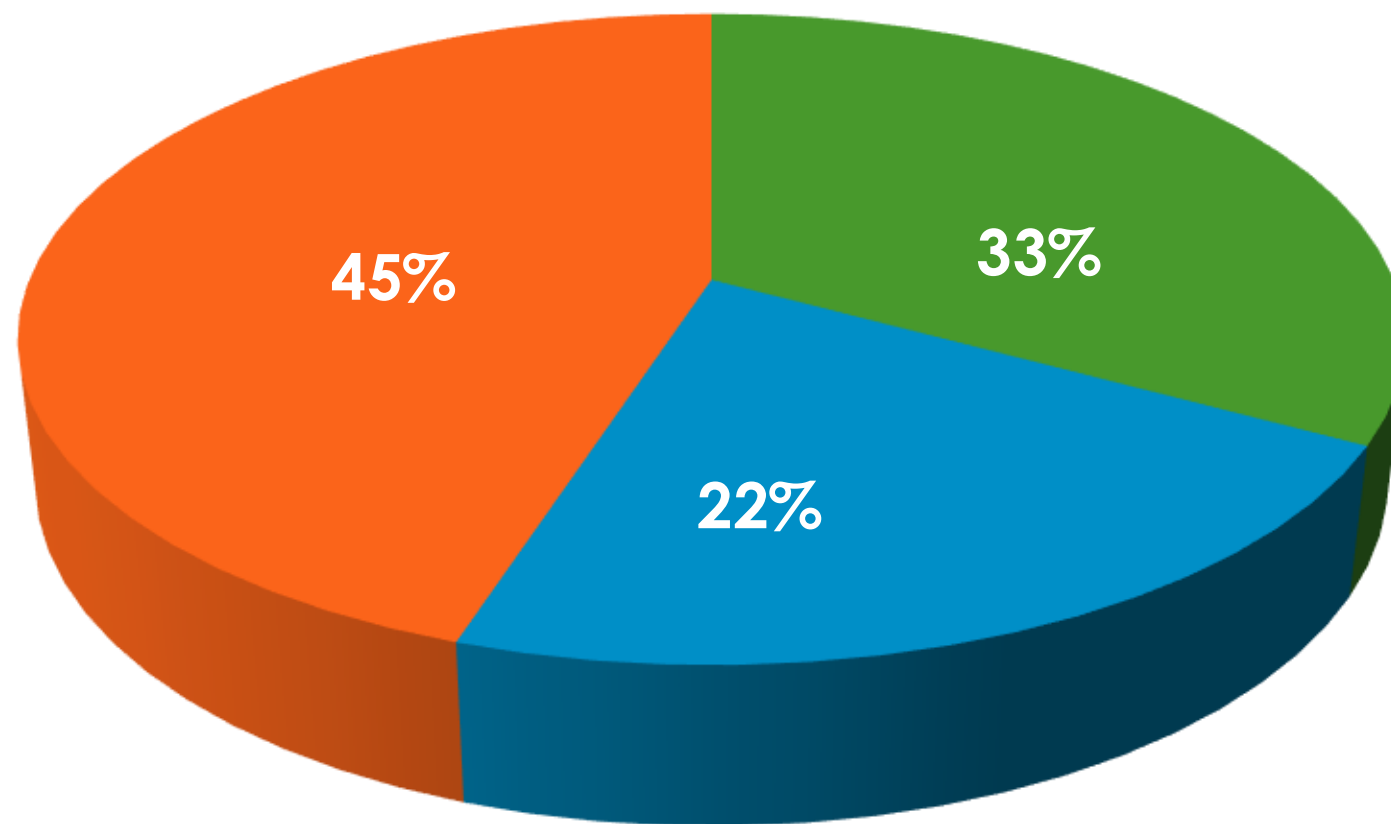

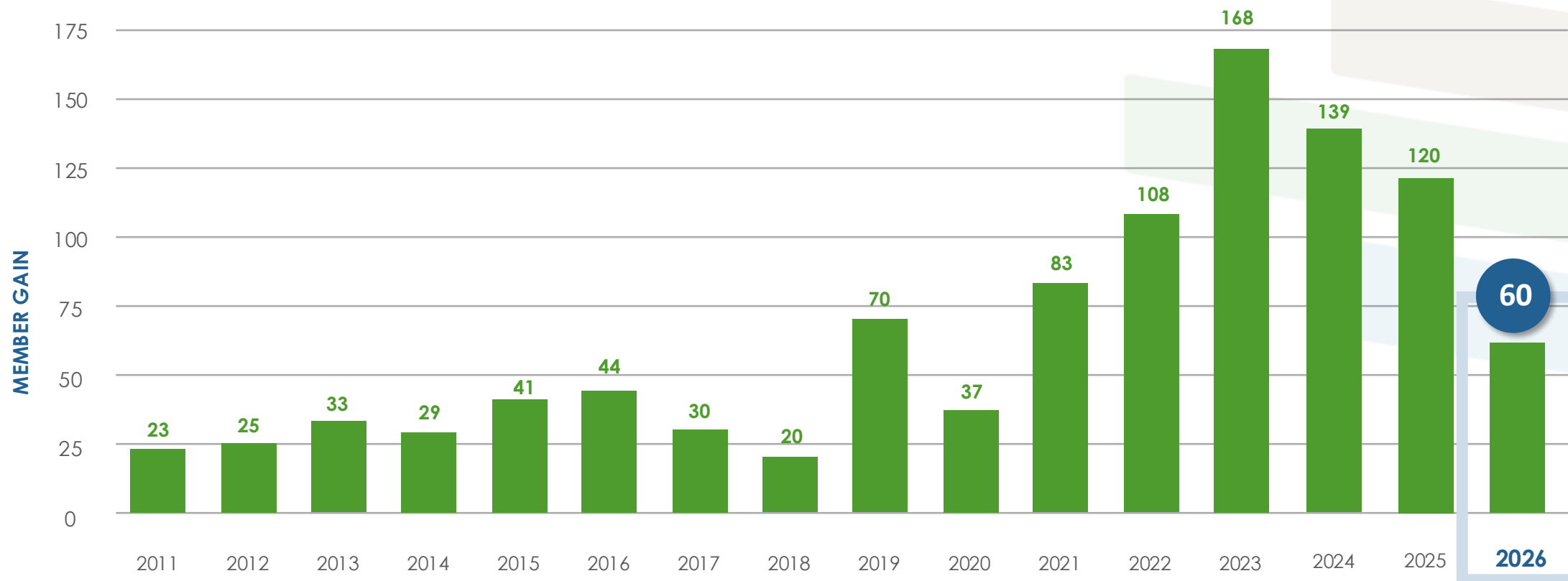
